5. Home grown produce has a natural bloom which is a white powdery coating. Effort should be made to preserve this natural coating on entries. Please gently remove dirt and debris prior to entry drop off at the fair.
6. Exhibitors and visitors are not permitted in the exhibition area during judging. Judges will be available for a short time following the completion of the judging for questions.
