Rules and Regulations

1. PLEASE REVIEW OPEN CLASS ENTRY TIMES ON THE OPEN CLASS CALENDAR
2. All Exhibitors must have Season Pass or Membership Pass to enter categories.
3. Entry ticket must be *displayed* on equipment judged.
4. The best possible care will be taken of all equipment, but the Society or the Antique Equipment Clubs of Warren County will not be responsible for loss or damage to equipment on exhibition.
5. Judges' decision is final.
6. First, second and third places in each Class will be awarded ribbon and cash premiums, except for Classes 8, 9 and 10, which will be awarded a ribbon and cash for first place only.
8. The WCAS. has the authority to change the entry class if the equipment is entered in the wrong class.
9. Tractors may only be entered in one of the first four classes.
