5. All articles will be placed and taken down by fair committee and assistants.
6. All articles exhibited must be original work of the exhibitor.
7. When there is but one entry in a group, it must be worthy to receive a prize.
8. Only one entry in each class to be shown on an exhibitor's ticket.
9. Exhibitors and visitors are not permitted in the exhibition area during judging.
