PLEASE REVIEW THE OPEN CLASS ENTRY CALENDAR FOR TIMES.

1. The best possible care will be taken of all goods, but the Society will not be responsible for loss or damage to articles on exhibition.
2. Entries must be displayed in locations assigned by superintendent and taken down by department staff.
3. Entries must be ready for display (easel, stand or base, hanger if appropriate). Help us make your pieces look their best.
4. Entries must fit on a 16" shelf and be no more than 20" wide and 24" tall.
5. Exhibitors must have entry tags on when entering. No article will be displayed unless tagged.
6. Exhibitors must show their exhibitor's ticket when entering and before receiving items at close of Fair.
7. All articles exhibited must be new and original and must be the handiwork of exhibitor.
8. Entries must have been finished within the last 2 years.
9. When there is but one entry in a group, it must be worthy to receive a prize.
10. Only one entry in each class be shown on an exhibitor's ticket.
11. Exhibitors and visitors are not permitted in the exhibition area during judging. Judges will be available for questions after judging.
12. BEST OF SHOW will be awarded in Creative Arts.

SECTION C – LEATHER ART

Leather may be carved, stamped, dyed, painted or stained but will be judged solely on overall leather craftsmanship.

Leather must be visible on at least 50% of the exterior surface.

2. Small case (holster, wallet, clutch, phone case, sheath, etc)
3. Large Case (shoulder bag, rifle case, briefcase, book/Bible cover, etc)
4. Decorative Item

SECTION D - ORIGAMI

Judging guidelines: complexity, presentation and workmanship as well as creative use of materials and overall originality will all be considered. (See www.ohiopaperfolders.com)

Class

1. Floral
2. Geometric/Modular
3. Traditional (non-modular design)
4. Money Folds

SECTION E: PAPER ARTS

Judging criteria: originality of design, presentation, workmanship as well as choice and creative use of materials.

Class

1. Collage/decoupage
2. Handcrafted greeting cards
3. Three-dimensional specimen
4. Other specimen – rubber stamping, art, calligraphy, etc.

SECTION F– GLASS ART

- This section includes stained glass.
- The use of wine glasses and bottles is allowed.
- Upcycled windows and mirrors is encouraged.
- Please use battery source for any lighted items; no access to electric will be provided.

Judging guidelines: originality, use of color and craftsmanship will be considered.

Class

1. Free standing item
2. Hanging Piece (max. 24” by 30”)
3. Utility specimen- non-decorative (tray, cutting board, etc.)

SECTION G – METAL ART

Class

1. Wire sculpture – small
2. Wire sculpture – large
3. Metal sculpture – small
4. Metal sculpture – large
5. Moving sculpture
6. Nuts and Bolts Art
7. Metal art using saw blades, license plates, car parts, etc

SECTION H- WOODWORKING

Class

SECTION I - PHOTOGRAPHY

- Only one print per category may be submitted by one exhibitor.
- All prints must be 5" x 7" or larger, and must be mounted on self-supporting material, no larger than 12" x 14".
- Judging guidelines: technical, visual and general characteristics.
- Classes 11 and 12 will change each year – watch for new opportunities!
- Best of Show will be awarded in Photography

- SIX OR MORE SNAPSHOTS, color or black and white, to be mounted on self- supporting material, 20" high and 16" wide.
- The pictures must be mounted so the board can be displayed vertically.

- BEST OF SHOW will be awarded in snapshots

SECTION L – DECORATIVE PAINTING

Tole and decorative painting is defined as the method of painting designs on any object to decorate or to make a picture. It may utilize a variety of techniques and media decorate functional and nonfunctional surfaces. Items may be wood, metal, glass or other materials. Classes are determined by primary focus of the piece.
