1. Only one entry in each class to be shown on an exhibitor's ticket. **Entry Fee: \$1 / entry**
2. The best possible care will be taken of all goods, but the Society will not be responsible for loss or damage to articles on exhibition.
3. Goods must be displayed in places assigned by Superintendent.
4. Exhibitors must have entry tags on when entering. No article will be displayed unless tagged.
5. Exhibitors must show their exhibitor's ticket when entering and before receiving items.
6. All articles will be placed and taken down by fair committee and assistants.
7. All articles exhibited must be original work of the exhibitor.
8. When there is but one entry in a group, it must be worthy to receive a prize.
9. Exhibitors and visitors are not permitted in the exhibition area during judging.
