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Dear Junior Fair Supporter,

Thank you for your interest in supporting the youth of the county at the Warren County Fair Livestock Sales. Please review the enclosed guidelines and details regarding this year's Sale and complete and return the Buyer Registration to the Sr. Fair Office at your earliest convenience. Although the health requirements due to the COVID-19 pandemic have been lifted, we do still have some resulting guidelines in place. Please note the following:

- We strongly encourage buyers to complete their buyer registration online by going to the following link <https://www.warrencountyfairohio.org/media/2021/2021%20Jr-%20Fair%20Livestock%20Sale%20BUYER%20REGISTRATION%20-%20FILL.pdf>. This will decrease the amount of time standing in line on Sale day and encourage distancing within the sale office.
- All buyers will be invoiced. To ensure accuracy of group purchases, please allow about a week to receive your statement after Fair. Payments can be mailed upon receipt of your auction statement or paid in the Sr. Fair office in the Event Center with cash, check or credit card (+4%) following Fair.
- Last year, demand for freezer beef was high, and as such, you may not have won the bid on cattle. This year our market beef numbers have increased to 70 head, compared to less than 50 last year, providing more opportunities for buyers. We encourage you to come Saturday to bid again on quality beef for your freezer!
- Processors have been secured for all major livestock in the Sale, but processing slots have been limited due to the disruption in the supply chain throughout the pandemic. We encourage you to bid early on both pork and beef to ensure your choice of processor.
- We will again have blank buyer boards available for you to pick up on sale day and the exhibitors will be mailing you a picture with their thank you notes after the Fair. Don't forget to pick up your plaque at the Sale office to promote your support of our Jr. Fair exhibitors!

Your enclosed entry pass admits two buyers to the 2021 Warren County Fair on Thursday, July 22<sup>nd</sup> and Saturday, July 24<sup>th</sup>. Please mark the sale dates on your calendar! You are also invited to the annual Recognition Breakfast to be held 8 – 10 AM in the Event Center prior to the Saturday Sale. The Sale Office will open Thursday at 4 PM in the JFB Office/Bldg. D. Saturday morning, buyer information will be available at 9 AM in the office next to Bldg. E. If you wish to make a Sale add-on, it must be done by Wednesday, July 28<sup>th</sup>.

Again this year, the Sale Committee is partnering with Warren County Farm Bureau & Shared Harvest Foodbank to present "Feed a Neighbor, Support Our Future." This program allows buyers to support our 4H livestock exhibitors by buying a hog and donating this purchase to Shared Harvest which serves seven food banks in our county. This program will be limited to 50 market hog purchases this year.
